### The 2024 Hall of Fame inductees will include:

#### Individuals

**Mike Halvorson 1969**  
Mike was Border League Tournament Champion in Golf with 28-5-3 record in head-to-head matches.

**Erik Muelheims 2014**  
Erik was All-League and All-State in Soccer and Basketball, scoring 1627 points.

**Will Tender 2014**  
Will was All-League, All-State, and started the most games in Boys Basketball history, scoring 1246 point. Also on State Track & Cross Country teams.

**Dexter Sienko 2014**  
Dexter scored 1560 points in 3 years of Basketball, earning League MVP and All-State honors. Also a 3-year starter in Baseball and played Soccer.

**Collin Cremers 2016**  
Collin was Co-State Player of the Year in Soccer. Also All-League in Basketball and played Tennis doubles at State.

**Isaac Werkman 2016**  
Isaac was All-League in Baseball for 3 years and a 2-year starter in Basketball. Also All-GSL twice in Football.

**Madison Ward 2017**  
Madison was an 11-time State Champion running on SGS Track & Cross Country teams.

**Hailey Higashi 2017**  
Hailey scored 1785 career points in Basketball as an All-League and All-State athlete.

Team was 2013 State Champions and 2014 State Runner up, with a 58-2 record over 2-year period.

Teams were back-to-back State Champions.
